

## FOUNDATION FUTURE OF THE CARBON MARKET

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Call for Proposals

The Foundation Future of the Carbon Market invites project developers and investors to submit proposals for emission reduction activities based on a programmatic carbon market approach.

The Foundation has the intention to buy emission reduction certificates generated by programmatic activities under UNFCCC or comparable domestic carbon market schemes. Supported programmes shall promote innovative solutions to mobilize funding for climate protection via markets. They shall have pioneering potential to kick off follow up activities and thus promote wider structural change.

The Foundation believes that the integration of carbon market activities into the policy frameworks of the host country is essential for attaining the goal of long lasting structural change. Hence, the Foundation's funding priority in the ongoing round is on programmes which are implemented as part of, or accompanied by ambitious Government policies which promote a climate resilient development path in the country. The Foundation strongly endorses internationally coordinated efforts under the UNFCCC and believes that the structures provided within this process, such as NAMAs and INDCs, provide for a credible basis which carbon markets should increasingly build on. The Foundation underlines that new carbon market activities should reflect in their planning the legal and practical challenges of transition requirements towards a new climate agreement after 2020.

The Foundation seeks to achieve a diverse project portfolio that includes programmes which involve households and civil institutions, in particular in Least Developed Countries. Technologies which are already strongly represented in the Foundation's portfolio, such as cook stoves will be treated with low priority.
